Notes from the Pastor's Desk



"Warmth in Winter"

It's been hard watching snowbirds fly south for the winter. It's even harder when they call up and talk about the great weather their having as I slip and slide through the day freezing. Unlike Pastor Lisa, who lived in Florida for five years, I have never lived anywhere that didn't have winter. And if you asked me in Spring, Summer, or Fall, I would likely tell you that I like the change of seasons and would miss not having them.

But it's winter. And I'm thinking about how we experience winter in our lives. Some people spend time thinking about things like what would it be like if our lives never had any bad things happen (they're called philosophers and they have really long academic names for topics like this.) And theologians like to think about what happens after death and what the Bible promises to those who die in the faith (and of course, we call that heaven.) And the Bible seems to talk about heaven as a place with no night, no rain...sort of sounds like no bad weather in heaven. I just can't imagine heaven with black ice, a foot of snow, and wind chills of 30 below. But then I didn't grow up in the north, maybe that is heaven for some folks.

But when I think of winter in our lives, I wonder what it would be like, not to live in spiritual Florida, but to live in Antarctica without any summer. I watch some people go through life without summers, or at least very few of them. And I know that for me, vacations to warmer climates is what can keep me going on the coldest nights. I know I can stand the cold because I have felt the warmth of Jesus' love in my life. I know I can get through a blizzard because I have experienced pleasant days of worship in the Lord's resort and spa called church. I know that I will be better equipped for long nights because I spent time walking in the hot summer sun of the Holy Spirit in the past. I relish my times praying, reading the Bible, and enjoying times of worship because I
