

Notes From Our Pastor

Pastor Bruce and I agree: October is a good month for anniversaries. Our wedding anniversary is October 12 (it will be 4 years for us this year), but a more important event in the history of the world is being celebrated this month: the 500th anniversary of the



Now, why should we in the 21st century care about a German monk who, on October 31, 1517, nailed his 95 objections to abuses going on in the church, on a church door in Wittenburg?

We care, and we celebrate this event, because what that German monk, Martin Luther, did, changed the world. The fact that we can read the Bible in English is due in large part to Luther's translation of the Bible into the German language, opening up God's word to the

common people. And the fact that we can worship God freely, as we choose, is also due in part to what he did.

Protestant Reformation.

But perhaps the greatest gift of the Reformation was summed up in what are called the Solas: Sola Fide (only faith), Sola Gratia (only Grace) and Sola Scriptura (only Scripture). Put simply, Martin Luther said that we are saved by faith alone, through grace alone, and that only Scripture is our authority.

Perhaps that last item, Sola Scriptura, would be a good point of reflection for this month. Because for us, Scripture is more than words on a page. Scripture is the Word of God, enfleshed in Jesus Christ. So as we read Scripture, we are invited to enter ever more deeply into a relationship with the Word of God, Jesus himself.

That will be the goal of our preaching for October, to explore the hallmarks of the Lutheran faith, all with an eye toward inviting you into that kind of relationship with Christ. As you hear the Scripture read and proclaimed, may you feel embraced by the Living Word, Jesus Christ, and may that relationship set you free.




